



July was a busy month with lots of racing, and many members cruising. I had a chance to visit Oswego and Fair Haven Yacht clubs, and enjoyed meeting some of their officers and members. These visits also reminded me to appreciate our club's friendly and simple policy of offering free reciprocal docks, and having the freedom as a club to choose that policy, as I learned not all clubs can. The response I get when I say I'm from Pultneyville is sincere, and consistent: "Oh, we love visiting Pultneyville." We should all feel proud of the contribution we make to boating life on Lake Ontario, and look for opportunities to maintain and even build on it. It's a relatively small community, and we have a great reputation.






Summer (2017) storage for cradles, stands, trailers: \$20.00


